

INSTRUCTION FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

Your paper has been selected for the Poster Show. This is a great opportunity to present your work, your institute and yourself to large audience during the poster sessions. Well presented posters draw a high level of attention and offer many opportunities for discussion during the symposium.

Please observe the following instructions when preparing your visual presentation.

- 1. Two Sessions are planned for presentation of the posters, mounted in the designated poster area:
 - Poster Session I: Monday 1 July, 2024 after lunch ca. 1.25h
 - Poster Session II: Tuesday
 2 July, 2024 after lunch ca. 1.25h

Poster boards will be ready from Monday, 1 July, 2024, 10:00h

All posters must be mounted at the latest at 12:00h Monday, 1 July, 2024.

Poster stickers will be provided. No staples, thumbtacks, pins or needles can be used.

2. The sketch of the poster board arrangement can be found below.

á	a. <u>Technical Content</u>	has to be put into the 84-90 cm wide and 120-128 cm high main poster area (=A0 - Worldformat). Use the entire area for your technical content.
k	p. <u>Personal Information</u>	on authors (CV), institute, company, laboratory (main goals), etc. have to be shown in an additional area of 29.7 cm height and 21 cm width (format A4) on the upper right part of the board.
•	c. <u>GSM-ID, Title</u>	of your presentation, your <u>name</u> and <u>affiliation</u> according to abstract, will be provided by the organiser and appear also in an additional area format A3 on the upper left part of the board.

3. Recommendations

- Please post only the <u>essentials</u> in the poster. Restrict yourself to <u>highlights, results, innovative ideas</u> etc. The complete text of your presentation will be included in the electronic Symposium Proceedings.
- Please use the "Arial" font (normal and/or bold) and the following letter sizes to make sure that all essential information can be read from a distance of 1.5 m (6').

Headlines: 48 pts (bold) Subheadings: 30 points (bold)

Text and equations: 18 points (normal)
